HOW TO OBTAIN BOOKS

Books in the Library may be obtained by communicating your request verbally, by phone, by letter or by email to the Honorary Librarian. Please quote the book number, title and author as set out **in this list**. Your name and address and phone and/or email should be clearly stated.

Country members may borrow books on the understanding that they will pay the postage both ways. This is most conveniently done by enclosing mint stamps to the value of the postage when the book is returned.

LIMITATIONS ON BORROWING

Books and other items may be borrowed free of charge for one month unless there is prior arrangement. Thereafter a fee of 5 cents is chargeable for every week the book is overdue. It is desirable that no more than two books per member be requested at any one time.

The SGAP Regional Council has decided that books difficult to replace should not be lent without special arrangements. Books in this category at present are all identified with the letter R in their book number.
